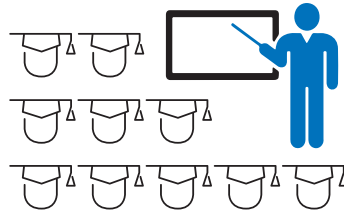

**3. Wheaton helps create changemakers.** We have a longstanding commitment to promoting equality, equity, inclusion and social justice, reflected in faculty and student research, campus programming and curriculum. Recent developments in this area include receiving a \$10 million grant to support social entrepreneurship—encouraging students to develop innovative solutions to global issues—and programs such as Three Freedoms, which promotes thoughtful conversation and celebrates diverse perspectives around important topics.

**4. Wheaton helps students generate powerful outcomes.** Wheaton grads succeed in the world beyond our campus. Just six months after graduating, 97 percent of Wheaton alumni are employed, enrolled in graduate school, engaged in meaningful internships or service. Since 2000, we have produced 3 Rhodes Scholars, 107 Fulbright Fellows, 18 Watson Fellows, 6 Truman Scholars, and many additional prestigious award winners. 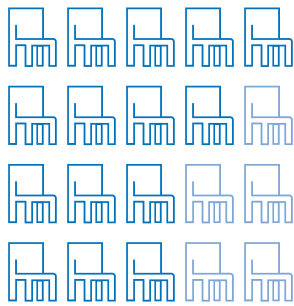
